### Introducing SunChoice: OUC's New Solar Energy Program

OUC is excited to announce **SunChoice**. This new program is designed to make clean, sustainable energy more accessible to everyone, including renters and those unable to install solar panels.

*What's New?* For residential customers, starting March 1, 2025, you can subscribe up to 100% of your monthly electricity usage in 10% increments. The new solar rate is \$0.04667 per kWh, an average annual increase of \$20 for those using 1000 kWh.

For commercial customers, starting October 1, tiered pricing applies, and subscriptions include Green-e<sup>®</sup> certified Renewable Energy Certificates (RECs).

## Don't Fall for Utility Scams



November 20 marks Utility Scam Awareness Day, a day dedicated to educating customers about common utility scams. If you receive a call, email or text asking for personal information or requesting immediate payment to avoid disconnecting your utility services, it's a scam. Hang up or ignore the message. If someone comes to your home making similar threats, don't engage—call the police.

Scammers "spoof" caller IDs to appear as utility companies, warning that your utility bill is overdue and demanding payment. These tactics are used via phone calls, emails, or texts. **OUC will never call, email or text you demanding immediate payment or request personal information**. Payments should only be made through OUC's website or by calling OUC Customer Service 407-423-9018.

If you suspect a scam, contact OUC and local law enforcement.

#### Tips to avoid scams:

- Beware of "spoofing" attempts
- Don't share personal or financial information
- Don't click links in suspicious emails or texts
- Never wire money to anyone claiming to represent OUC

#### **Community Corner:** *OUC Employees Drive Community Revitalization Through Empowerment Zone Taskforce*



OUC's Empowerment Zone Taskforce is leading multiple community initiatives aimed at revitalizing the 32805 ZIP code, one of Orlando's most economically disadvantaged zip codes. The Empowerment Zone Taskforce seeks to help revitalize the community by leveraging OUC's resources and partnerships to enhance educational opportunities, health and wellness programs, jobs training and sustainable housing.

Programs include trade skills training through the Pre-Apprenticeship Program, literacy initiatives

like Little Free Library and Need to Read, and an EV Technician Training Program. The taskforce also collaborates on energy-saving home improvements for low-income residents and provides career exposure for high school students. Health and wellness are promoted through the HEAL program, while OUC's partnership with 4Roots addresses the area's food scarcity with community gardens and sustainable food projects.
