

# Harmony II and Storey Bend Solar Energy Centers Will Double OUC's Solar Capacity

OUC – The *Reliable* One recently celebrated the grand opening of the largest solar project in its history. OUC, AdventHealth, Comcast NBCUniversal and Florida Renewable Partners gathered in Osceola County to unveil the Harmony II and Storey Bend Solar Energy Centers. The two 74.5-megawatt (MW) arrays, located on separate 600+ acre sites, will more than double OUC's existing solar capacity.

AdventHealth and Comcast NBCUniversal have signed on as anchor tenants – subscribing to a significant portion of each solar energy center through OUC SunChoice. The program enables commercial customers to support solar energy, while offsetting all or part of their electric consumption, and meet sustainability goals, without installing or maintaining the infrastructure themselves.

AdventHealth will offset 50% of their energy consumption in OUC's service territory by subscribing to the Harmony II Solar Energy Center. Comcast NBCUniversal will offset 30% of their energy consumption at Universal Studios, Islands of Adventure and CityWalk through their subscription to the Storey Bend Solar Energy Center.

Florida Renewable Partners, a division of NextEra Energy, built the solar arrays and will continue to operate them. OUC has signed a 20-year power purchase agreement to receive the clean energy produced at Harmony II and Storey Bend.

With the new facilities, OUC's solar energy portfolio totals 271.5 MW of capacity, or enough to power 50,000 typical Florida homes.

#### **INDOOR SAFETY:**

- Use correct wattage bulbs
- for damage Inspect electrical cords for damage
- Replace faulty appliances
- Cover unused outlets
- Never remove the third prong of plugs
- Test smoke alarms monthly, change batteries yearly



#### **OUTDOOR SAFETY:**

- Call 8-1-1 before digging
- **f** Keep kids and pets away from power tools
- Avoid using electrical devices in wet conditions
- Use outdoor-rated extension cords
- Stay 10 feet from power lines
- Look when you're walking. Watch out for open water meter boxes
